

## CELEBRATING EXAM SUCCESS AT CAYMAN PREP AND HIGH SCHOOL



The staff of Cayman Prep and High School offer warmest congratulations to our Graduating Classes of 2010. The Year 11 students set a new record by achieving 100% pass rate! Our curriculum is academically rigorous with most students taking 11 or 12 examination IGCSE (Cambridge) or GCSE subjects.

The recognised measure of success is the percentage of students gaining five or more of the higher passes at grades A\*– C. Once again, a record was achieved with an astounding 92% of our students gaining the requisite 5 or more A\* - C passes. The Year 11 top achievers of 2010 are as follows:

Our Sixth Form Year 13 graduates achieved notable success in the prestigious Cambridge A-level examinations. Mona Hussein gained 2 of the new A\*grades, an additional A grade and also a 'b' grade at AS-level Greek. She is now studying medicine in the university of her choice, Imperial College, London. Justine Foreman, who gained 1A\*, 1A,1B and 1C pass is now at Nottingham University studying veterinary sciences. Michael Daley was awarded a full Butterfield scholarship to study architecture at Savannah College of Arts & Design, Georgia. Other students have gone to universities and colleges such as Bristol (engineering); Plymouth (fine arts); Sheffield Hallam (law); Sheffield (human geography); Portsmouth (business), North Eastern University (business) and Texas Technical College (business).

The school's new building has certainly increased the potential and scope of all high school work. Its excellent facilities include 5 science labs, 2 IT labs, a large library and 10 classrooms. Our arts facilities in the main building have been refurbished to include 2 art rooms and a drama studio, thanks to very generous donations from Butterfield and our own PTA. The Sixth Form centre now has two study rooms and careers and university admissions offices which will ensure that all students have full access to the resources they need as they plan their next steps in further education. We have added Economics, Media Studies and Travel & Tourism to our IGCSE programme and Marine Science in the Sixth Form.

We are proud of our students and of their many wonderful achievements which go well beyond the academic. Recently, we have introduced Robotics as an extra-curricular activity and hope to send a team to compete in the USA. We have sports men and women who regularly represent their country in swimming, squash, netball, basketball and football, to name but a few. We have fine musicians, eloquent debaters and talented actors. Our students enjoy trips to Orlando, Washington, London and Paris, and Costa Rica. We have an extremely active Key Club, participate in the Duke of Edinburgh awards programme at bronze, silver and gold levels, and encourage leadership initiatives such as attendance at the Global Young Leaders Conferences, membership of the Youth Assembly and involvement in Young Entrepreneurs and Junior Achievement activities.
