CAMP RULES

1. Campers are expected take full part in all the activities and to be on time
2. Respect everyone. Treat your fellow campers as you wish to be treated
(Golden Rule)
3. Keep our 'home' clean – dorms, bathrooms, hall, and the compound in general.
4. No camper is allowed to leave the compound unless permission is given by camp parents or camp director, and with their parent's consent.
5. Boys only in the boy's dorm and girls only in the girls dorm
6. Absolutely no 'tooth pasting' or other disrespectful things to others
7. The following areas are out of bounds unless you are with a leader: the beach, the road side, the leader's room, the house garden and the cemetery.
8. **No one** is allowed on the rocky shoreline at any time!
9. Food can be brought for you at camp as long as there is enough to share with *the whole camp*
10. No cell phones. If parents need to contact campers, they must call camp parents.
11. No ipods, video games or electronic gadgets.
12. If a camper destroys/ damages property then they will be sent home immediately and parents will be required to cover damages made.
- 13. Note the following overriding terms for use of the Prospect Youth Centre:
"A Christian life-style at the Centre is mandatory for all registering groups. Consumption, holding or use of alcoholic beverages or drugs (except those prescribed by a physician), violence, vulgarity, immorality, are not permitted. The United Church has full authority to expel any person/ group if this is ignored or contravened."**
