Schedule and Records

9. The Regional Mission Council shall, at the January meeting, obtain from each Congregation the schedules issued by Synod; and it shall ascertain that the queries set forth are fully answered and correctly tabulated.

10. The Regional Mission Council shall examine the records of each Congregation; the Communion Roll, financial records, Minutes of the Congregational Board, baptismal records and Log Books.

These records shall be attested by the Chairperson of the Regional Mission Council at the January meeting.

Members of Synod Boards and Committees

11. At the January meeting, the Regional Mission Council shall make such nominations to the Synod Boards and Committees as are necessary.
